An Illustration of the Hebrew Verb Stems and their Root Groups

This illustration is an attempt to present visually the Hebrew verbal system. The following are presentations of the 7 verb stems: קַל, הָפְעַל, הַפְּעַל, הַפְּעַל, הַפְּעַל, הַפְּעַל, הַפְּעַל, הַפְּעַל, הַפְּעַל, הַפְּעַל, הַפְּעַל, בּמָל, בּמַל, בּמל, במּמל, במּל, במּמל, במיל, במ

Each verb stem has its basic, 'strong' verb paradigm for all forms: prefix form, suffix form, participle, imperative & infinitives (Tools No. 11a, 14-17).

The front darker color page of each paradigm illustrated below, represents the 'strong' verbs. The pages that follow in lighter hues of grey represent the paradigm of each verb stem for the different 'weak' root groups: first letter ', third letter ', third letter ', etc. which may deviate from the 'strong' paradigm.
